## FOR INTERNATIONAL ADMITTED STUDENTS

*Congratulations on your admission, and welcome to the University of Minnesota Class of 2021!*

### 1. CONFIRM YOUR ENROLLMENT (Reserve your spot!)

When you confirm your enrollment, you are making a commitment to attend the University of Minnesota in the fall. After we receive your enrollment confirmation, we will reserve a place for you in the incoming class. You may confirm your enrollment online at <http://uofminn.org/confirm>.

**Important:** The deadline to confirm your enrollment for fall 2017 is **May 1**. Confirmation forms and fees received after the May 1st postmark deadline are accepted on a space-available basis.

### 2. SUBMIT A FINANCIAL CERTIFICATION STATEMENT

The Financial Certification (fincert) statement is needed for the U of M to issue an I-20. Submit your fincert statement online at [z.umn.edu/submitfincert](http://z.umn.edu/submitfincert), or download the PDF at [admissions.tc.umn.edu/PDFs/FinCert.pdf](http://admissions.tc.umn.edu/PDFs/FinCert.pdf). ### 3. APPLY FOR CAMPUS HOUSING

The housing application is available online at <http://www.housing.umn.edu/applying>.

**Freshman Housing Guarantee** - The University of Minnesota guarantees housing to all admitted first-year freshmen who are willing to accept assignment to any space designated, and who:

1. Submit the housing application-contract and \$25 non-refundable housing application fee to Housing & Residential Life no later than May 1; and
2. **Confirm their enrollment** with the Office of Admissions no later than May 1.

Students who apply for housing after May 1 are placed in housing on a space-available basis.

### 4. SUBMIT YOUR FINAL TRANSCRIPT

The deadline to submit your final transcript is August 1, 2017. In order to verify that you have met this enrollment requirement, you must have your secondary school send your official final secondary school transcript and proof of graduation (i.e., graduation certificate or leaving exam results) to the Office of Admissions.
