FOR INTERNATIONAL ADMITTED TRANSFER STUDENTS

Congratulations on your admission, and welcome to the University of Minnesota!

1. CONFIRM YOUR ENROLLMENT (Reserve your spot!)

When you confirm your enrollment, you are making a commitment to attend the University of Minnesota in the fall. After we receive your enrollment confirmation, we will reserve a place for you in the incoming class. You may confirm your enrollment online at <http://uofminn.org/confirm>.

Important: The deadline to confirm your enrollment varies by individual college. Contact your transfer specialist to discuss your college's confirmation deadline.

2. SUBMIT A FINANCIAL CERTIFICATION STATEMENT

The Financial Certification (fincert) statement is needed for the U of M to issue an I-20. Submit your fincert statement online at z.umn.edu/submitfincert, or download the PDF at admissions.tc.umn.edu/PDFs/FinCert.pdf. If you have questions, please contact the Admissions office at 1-612-625-2008.

3. ARRANGE FOR HOUSING

International transfer students should make housing arrangements prior to arriving on campus.

4. SUBMIT YOUR TRANSCRIPTS

Secondary school/high school transcript

Official documentation of successful completion of secondary school/high school graduation is a U of M enrollment requirement. Transcripts must be submitted to the Office of Admissions by August 1st.

College/university transcripts

Official, final transcripts (with English translation, if necessary) must be submitted directly to the Office of Admissions by November 1st from all colleges or universities that attended, even if no credit was earned.

5. PREPARE FOR ARRIVAL

After you confirm your enrollment and submit your Financial Certification Statement, you will receive important and helpful information from the University's International Student and Scholar Services (ISSS) office. ISSS will assist you as you prepare to arrive on campus, and they will work with you after your arrival in Minnesota.

6. COMPLETE ONLINE PROGRAMS FOR NEW STUDENTS
