## Minnesota Cooperative Admissions Program (MnCAP)

# Summary of Additional Conditions to be Met PRIOR TO ENROLLMENT AT THE UNIVERSITY

## For participating majors found in

### College of Biological Sciences (CBS)

- Maintain a preferred cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. This cumulative GPA includes coursework from all colleges attended.
- Complete one or more semesters of calculus and chemistry with a grade of C or higher. Students are strongly encouraged to meet with the CBS Transfer Admissions Counselor to help plan their transfer.

### College of Design (CDes) (Environmental Design [Landscape Architecture] and Housing Studies majors only)

- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or higher. This cumulative GPA includes coursework from all colleges attended.
- Earn grades of C or higher in all transfer courses related to major.
- Complete all high school preparation requirements.
- Submit Admission Application Supplement along with admission application.

### College of Education and Human Development (CEHD) (Family Social Science, Recreation Park & Leisure Studies, and Youth Studies majors only)

- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. This cumulative GPA includes coursework from all colleges you have attended.
- Earn grades of C or higher in all transfer courses related to major.
- Family Social Science applicants complete intermediate algebra with a grade of C- or higher as well as complete at least one social science course both prior to admission.
- Recreation Park & Leisure Studies applicants complete general psychology prior to admission
- Youth Studies applicants complete introduction to sociology as well as an additional social science course prior to admission
- Submit CEHD Transfer Application Supplement with admission application. CEHD MnCap advising: Arien Telles, 612-626-5682

### College of Food, Agricultural and Natural Resource Sciences (CFANS)

- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. This cumulative GPA includes coursework from all colleges you have attended.
- Demonstrate a strong foundation in math and science courses.

- Applicants to the Applied Economics and Pre-Ag & Food Business Management major must have completed college algebra with a grade of C or higher and must have completed microeconomics or macroeconomics with a grade of B- or higher. Preferred GPA of 2.8 or higher.
- Applicants to the Nutrition major must have completed one semester or two quarters of inorganic chemistry with lab with a grade of C- or higher, and one semester or one quarter of biology with lab with a grade of C- or higher. Preferred GPA of 2.8 or higher.
- Most successful applicants who wish to pursue the emphasis of Pre-Vet in the Animal Science major AND intend to apply to Veterinary School will have completed college algebra, one semester (or more) or general chemistry with lab, and one semester of general biology with lab, with grades of B or higher. Preferred cumulative GPA for this emphasis in Animal Science is 3.0 or higher.
- (Students are admitted to the major after meeting additional course and GPA requirements. Please see the undergraduate catalog for more information.)

### College of Liberal Arts (CLA)

- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. This cumulative GPA includes coursework from all colleges attended. (Note that the GPA requirement for Journalism & Mass Communication and for Computer Science majors is higher than 2.5.)
- Complete a second semester of a foreign language (for students who plan to pursue a BA, BFA in Art, or BIS degree).
- Pass any auditions or special exams (for music and dance majors) prior to matriculation in CLA.

### Institute of Technology (IT)
