Transfer Credit Resources

We recommend three online transfer credit resources to assist students in their transfer planning: the Liberal Education Course Transfer Guide, College of Science and Engineering (CSE) Transfer Plans and Equivalencies, and Transferology. Below, we have provided detailed instructions to make it easy for you to access each of these helpful guides:

Liberal Education Course Transfer Guide

This guide lists all courses by college that the University of Minnesota Twin Cities has evaluated to satisfy our specific Liberal Education requirements. This guide is useful to those students who do not plan to complete the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) but who would still like to take Liberal Education courses that will both transfer and satisfy UMNTC Liberal Education requirements. This guide is helpful to both students and advisers.

1. Go to <http://admissions.tc.umn.edu/admissioninfo/trans.html>
2. Click on “Transferring Credit”
3. In the list at the top of page, select “Liberal Education Course Transfer Guides”
4. On the next page, select your transfer institution’s state
5. Select your institution from the list on the page

1. Go to <http://admissions.tc.umn.edu/admissioninfo/trans.html>
2. Click on “Transferring Credit”
3. Click on “College of Science and Engineering Transfer Plans and Equivalencies”
4. Select “plans” for CSE Transfer Plans or “course equivalencies” for CSE Transfer Guides.
5. On the next page, select your transfer institution’s state
6. Select your institution from the list on the page

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Transferology

This online transfer credit database lists all transfer courses previously evaluated by the U of M Twin Cities. Students and advisors can follow the instructions listed below to create a course equivalency guide between their institution and the U of M Twin Cities.

1. Go to <http://transferology.com>
2. Create a profile
3. In the "School Name" field, type in the name of the college or university where you completed or are completing coursework.
4. Under the "Taken" header, select the term and year of the coursework completed.
5. In the "Department" field, type in the name of the department in which you would find your course. As you type, a list of departments will populate below. Click the appropriate department name.
6. A list of coursework will populate for your chosen department. To add a course to your list, click the green plus sign to the right of the course name.
7. Repeat steps 3-6 if you are looking for equivalencies for multiple courses.
8. Once you've added all the courses you wish to view equivalencies for, click on the "search for matches" button.
9. On the following webpage, a list of colleges and universities will populate. Type "University of Minnesota Twin Cities" into the top search bar, to filter your results. Click on the U of M's profile name.
10. Your course equivalency guide will appear on the following webpage. To view further details, such as U of M liberal education requirement fulfillments, click on the  icon next to the listed course equivalency.
